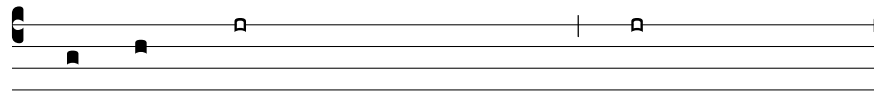
3. Restore our fortunes, O *LORD*, like the torrents in the



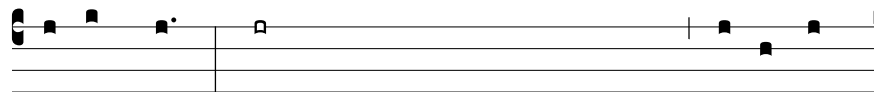
southern *des-ert*. Those that sow in tears shall *reap*



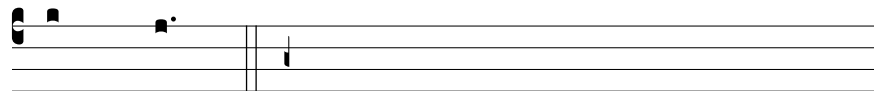
rejoicing. Ṛ.
