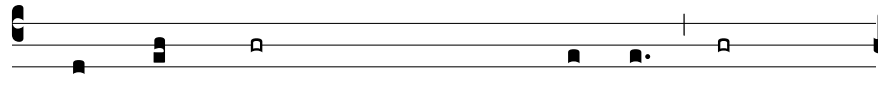

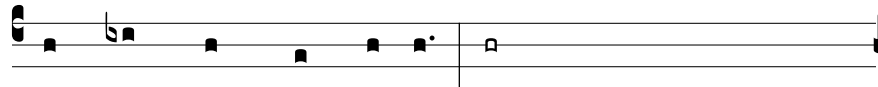

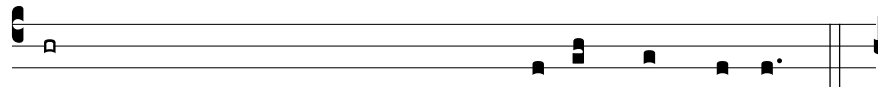

Let the Lord en-ter; he is king of glory.



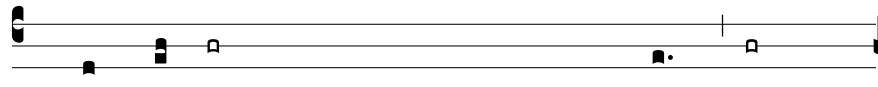
1. The LORD's are the earth and its *full-ness*; the world



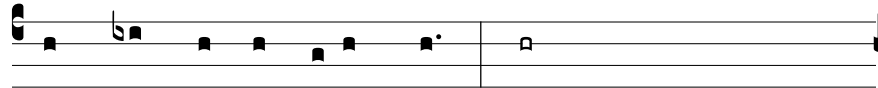
and *those* who dwell in it. For he founded it upon



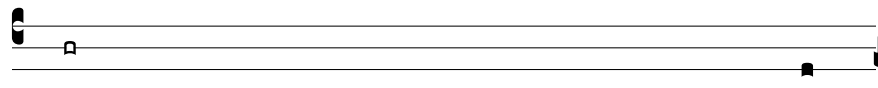
the seas and established it *up-on* the rivers. R̄.



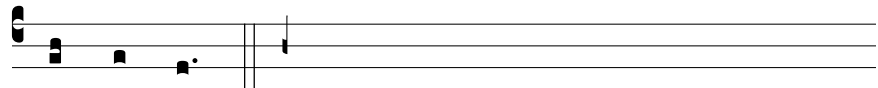
2. Who can ascend the mountain of the *LORD*? or who



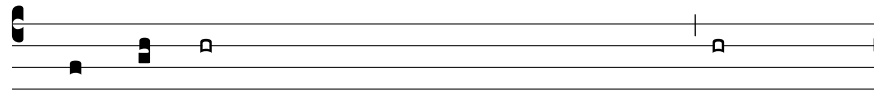
may *stand* in his holy place? One whose hands are



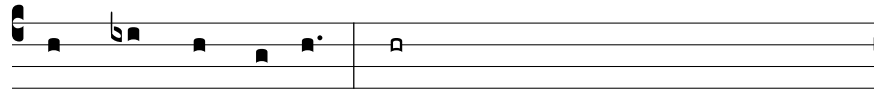
sinless, whose heart is clean, who desires *not*



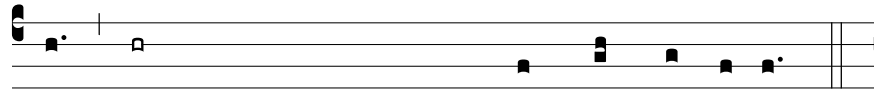
what is vain. R̄.
