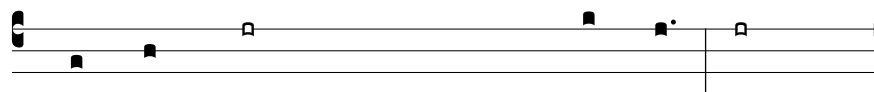
**T**oday is born our Sa-vior, Christ the Lord.



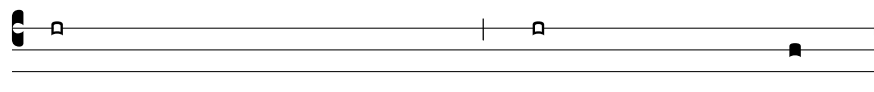
1. Sing to the LORD a new *song*; sing to the LORD,



*all* you lands. Sing to the LORD; bless his name. R̄.



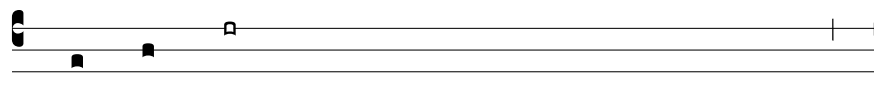
2. Announce his salvation, day *af-ter* day. Tell his



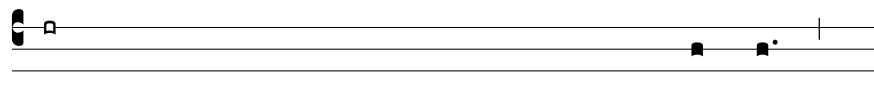
glory among the nations; among all *peo-ples*,



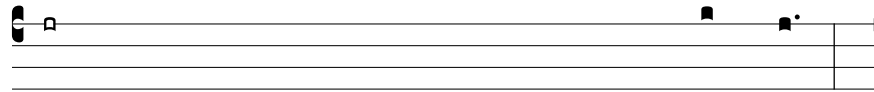
his wondrous deeds. R̄.



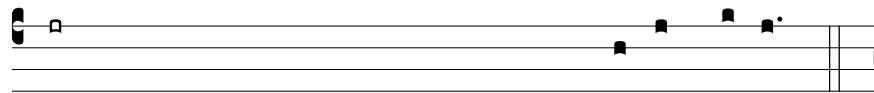
3. Let the heavens be glad and the earth rejoice;



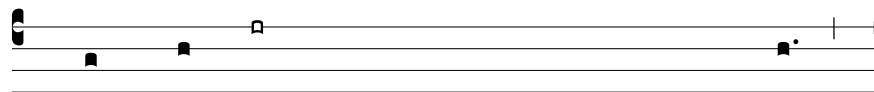
let the sea and what fills it *re-sound*;



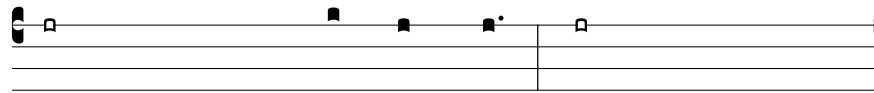
let the plains be joyful and all that is *in* them!



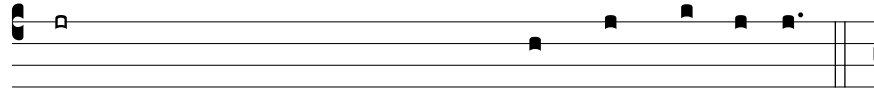
Then shall all the trees of the *for-est* exult. *R.*
