1. The LORD is gracious and merciful, slow to

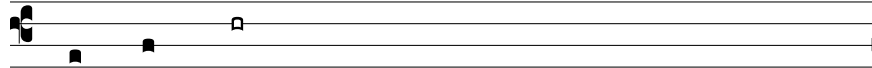
anger and of great *kind-ness*. The LORD is good to

all and compassionate *toward* all his works. *R.*

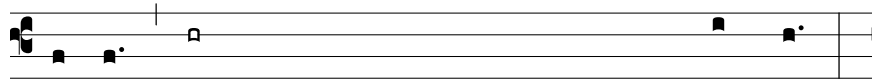
2. Let all your works give you thanks, O *LORD*, and let

your faithful ones *ble*ss you. Let them discourse of the

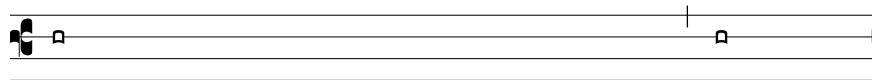
glory of your kingdom and speak *of* your might. *R.*



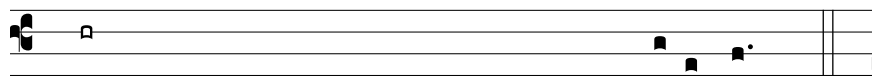
3. Let them make known your might to the children of
