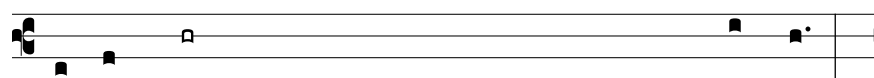
3. "In the written scroll it is prescribed *for* me, to do



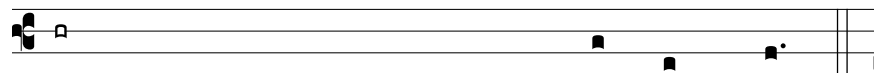
your will, O my God, is *my* delight, and your law is
