1. To you I lift up my eyes who are enthroned in

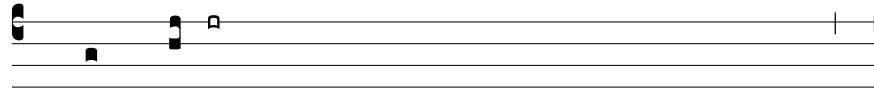
heav-en — as the eyes of servants are on the hands

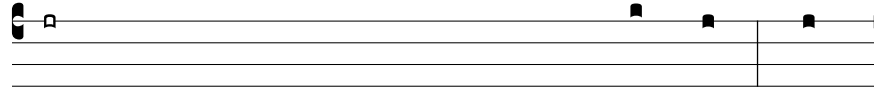
2. As the eyes of a maid are on the hands of her

mis-tress, so are our eyes on the LORD, our God,

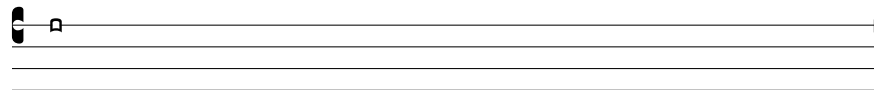
till he have *pit-y* on us. *R.*



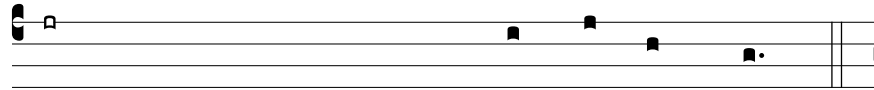
3. Have pit-y on us, O LORD, have pity on us,
