1. You have visited the land and wa-tered it;

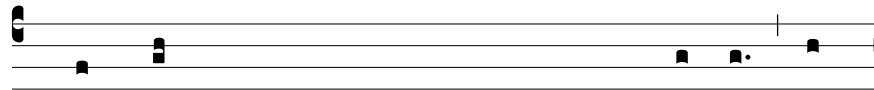

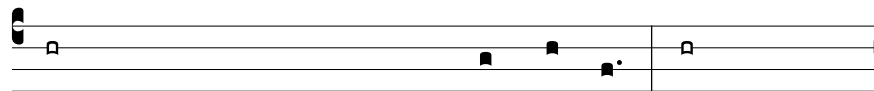
2. Thus have you prepared *the* land: drenching *its*

furrows, breaking up its clods, softening it with

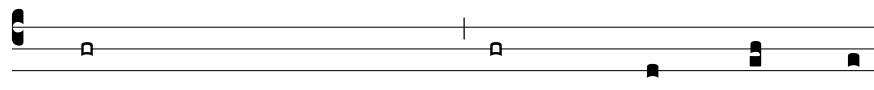
show-ers, bless-ing its yield. R̄.



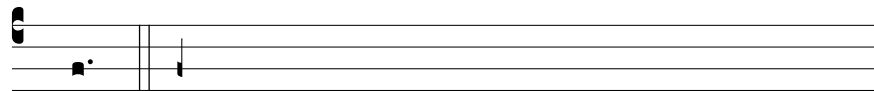
3. You have crowned the year with your *boun-ty*, and



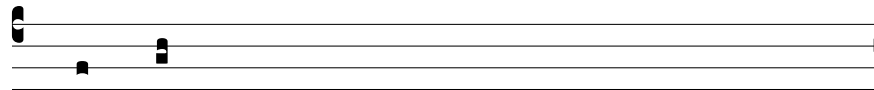
your paths overflow with a *rich* harvest; the untilled



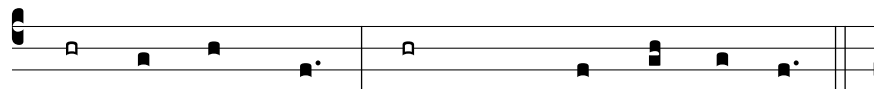
meadows overflow with it, and rejoic-*ing* clothes the
