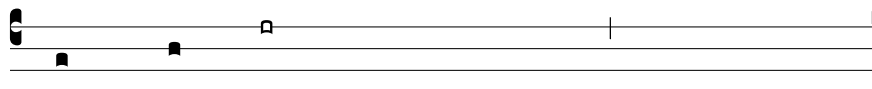
1. I will bless the LORD at all times; his praise shall



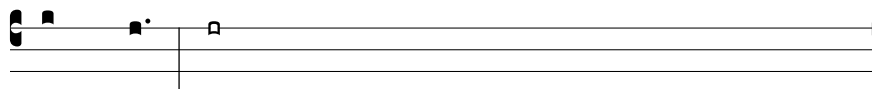
be ever in *my* mouth. Let my soul glory in



the LORD; the lowly will *hear* me and be glad. R̄.



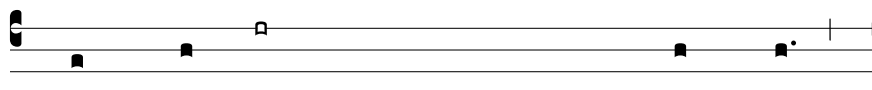
2. The LORD has eyes for the just, and ears for



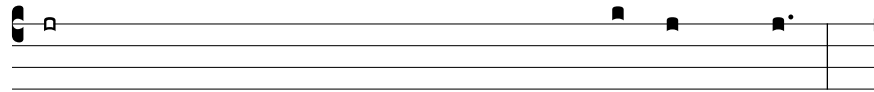
their cry. The LORD confronts the evildoers, to



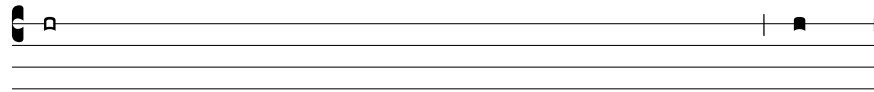
destroy remembrance *of* them from the earth. R̄.



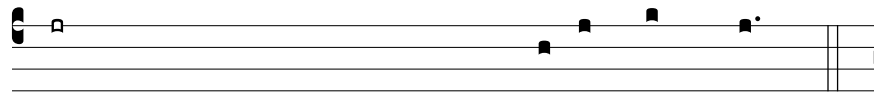
3. When the just cry out, the LORD *hears* them,



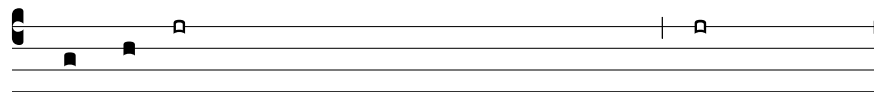
and from all their distress he *res-cues* them.



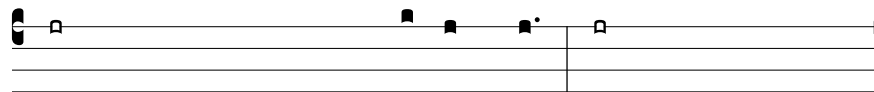
The LORD is close to the brokenhearted; and



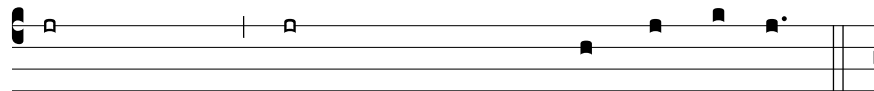
those who are crushed in *spir-it* he saves. *R̄.*
