





be full.

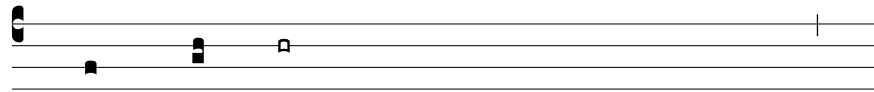


1. Hear, O LORD, a just suit; *at-tend* to my

deceit. R̄.

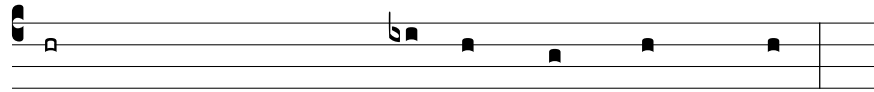


2. My steps have been steadfast in your paths, my *feet*

me, O God; incline your ear to *me*; hear my word. R̄.

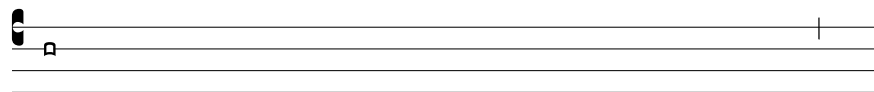




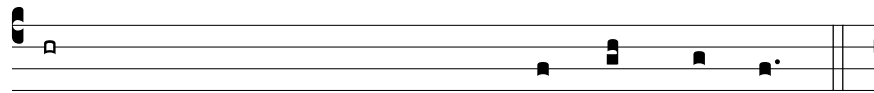
3. Keep me as the apple of your eye,
