he has redeemed from the hand of the foe

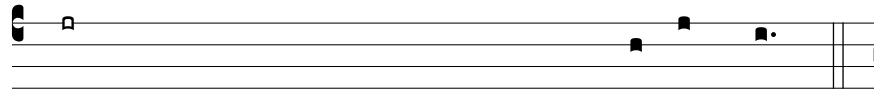

and *gath-ered* from the lands, from the east and


the west, from the north *and* the south. R̄.

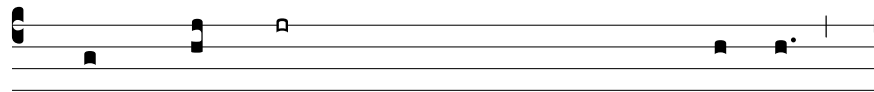

2. They went astray in the desert *wil-der-ness*; the way



to an inhabited city *they* did not find. Hungry and



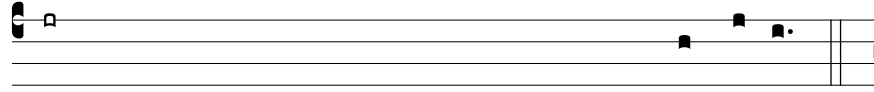
thirsty, their life was wasting away *with-in* them. Ṙ.



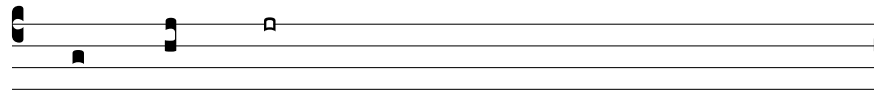
3. They cried to the LORD in their *dis-tress*;



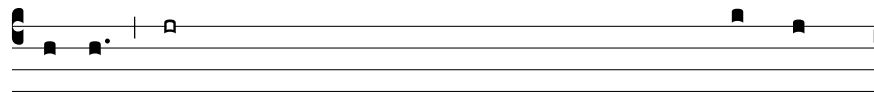
from their *straits* he rescued them. And he led them



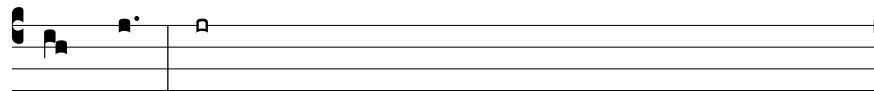

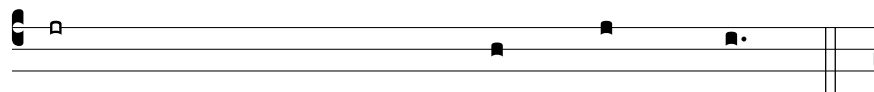
